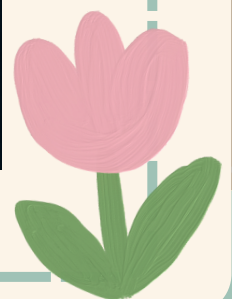


- Senior Fees are \$180 (+\$4.95 online fee)

Treats are *usually* once a month

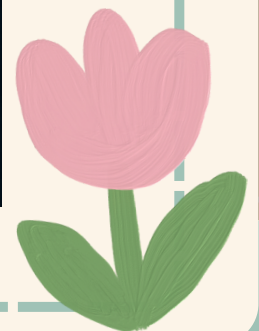

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Transcripts are your official record of all your high school grades and attendance.

Transcripts are available in a hard copy format or electronically.

The format that will depend on the college or scholarship you are applying to.

Hard copy transcripts are ordered on MPP.

Electronic transcripts are requested through Naviance.

Dual Enrollment transcripts are ordered through the college you are enrolled in (GTC, GGC, Ga Tech...)
