

MVHS Seniors Only Last Chance Credit Recovery Boot Camp, May 6-10 & May 13-17

The purpose of this credit recovery session is to help a senior that may fail a course they need for graduation. In order to participate in the May 2024 graduation ceremony, seniors must satisfy GPCS graduation requirements by May 22, 2024. Credit recovery allows students to earn credit for a course before the end of the semester and stay on track towards graduation. Student athletes seeking athletic scholarships should consult with their counselor prior to registering for Credit Recovery because it is not accepted by the NCAA.

Who is eligible?

- Seniors that may fail a class during spring semester.

When is Credit Recovery offered?

- For the SENIOR Last Chance Credit Recovery Boot Camp, credit recovery courses will be offered the week of **May 6-10 and May 13-17**.

How does the program work?

- MVHS uses Georgia Virtual School's online program for credit recovery. This is a self-paced class with embedded tests. Success is NOT guaranteed! It is up to the student to work diligently and seek assistance if needed. Content area teachers will be available to help.
- The student must have an account with GaVirtualSchool.org to be enrolled in a course.
- The counselor will enroll the student after payment is received and the student's account is set up.

When is the Credit Recovery Boot Camp?

- 2:30 pm-6:00 pm May 6-10 and the week of May 13-17.
- Students must attend in person and are permitted to leave early once they complete their course.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own snacks. Ordering food for delivery will take precious time away from their course.

What is the cost for the Last Chance Credit Recovery Boot Camp?

- \$50 per course payable on mypaymentsplus.com under the category Activities & Events, **MVHS CREDIT RECOVERY ENROLLMENT**.

Courses offered during the Last Chance Credit Recovery Boot Camp?

- Math- Geometry C&C, Algebra C&C, & Advanced Algebra C&C
- Language Arts- 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th grade
- Science/PE- Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy, Astronomy, Environmental Science, & Physics,
- Health
- Social Studies- World Geography, World History, US History, Government (Political Systems), & Economics

How do I sign my Senior for this Last Chance Credit Recovery Boot Camp?

- Sign up on mypaymentsplus.com under MVHS CREDIT RECOVERY ENROLLMENT.
- Registration is open now; the deadline to sign up is May 6.

How soon will I know if my child failed a class and is eligible for credit recovery?

- Please communicate with your child's teacher and/or counselor to determine if your student is eligible.
- Students are permitted to make up any eligible course.
- Refunds are not provided even if the senior ends up passing their actual MVHS course.

When will the Credit Recovery Course appear on my child's transcript?

- The Credit Recovery course and grade will appear on your child's transcript for graduation if they complete the course and earn a passing grade.

Will my student be able to participate in the May graduation ceremony if they participate in this session?

- If your student successfully completes their course and has all the credits needed for graduation by May 22, 2024, they will be able to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Students that fail to complete their course and fail to have met the graduation requirements by May 22, 2024 will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
