  - ZELL Miller Scholarship: 3.7 Academic GPA + 1200 on SAT or 26 on ACT

### **NAVIANCE:**


- Tool for personal Interests, skills, personality, college and career Exploration
- Students access their portfolio through e-class-available any time.
- Counselors conduct Naviance activities with students in Spring



## College Admissions

- GPA
- Course Selection (rigor; difficulty level) Selective colleges are looking at the strength or rigor of courses throughout high school, including senior year.
- Test Scores (SAT & ACT)/Test Optional
- Extracurricular Activities Leadership and participation in clubs, service, and sports can be particularly important to competitive colleges
- Personal Essays and letters of recommendation (if required)
- Volunteer Hours and Level




