





## APPLICATION COMPONENTS

- **Essays** Required essays on the college application are important because they demonstrate writing ability and give the college more information. Please seek advice when writing an essay and make sure to proofread for errors.
- Letters of Recommendation- Counselors and Teachers need 10 school days' notice to complete a letter of Recommendation. Brag Sheet is required for counselors to complete letters of rec. Brag sheets are on the Counseling Website.
- **Resume** Contains academic information, honors and awards, extracurricular activities, work/volunteer experience, etc.

## ypes of ADMISSION

#### **STUDENTS**: WHICH COLLEGE ADMISSION PROCESS BEST SUITS YOU?

#### **Non-Restrictive Application Plans**

**Regular Decision** 

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students submit an application by a specified date and receive a decision in a clearly stated period of time.

**COMMITMENT:** 

NON-BINDING

Rolling Admission

#### **DEFINITION:**

Institutions review applications as they are submitted and render admission decisions throughout the admission cycle.

**COMMITMENT:** 

NON-BINDING

Early Action (EA)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students apply early and receive a decision well in advance of the institution's regular response date.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Students are not restricted from applying to other institutions and have until May 1 to consider their options and confirm enrollment.

#### Restrictive Application Plans

Early Decision (ED)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students make a commitment to a first-choice institution where, if admitted they definitely will enroll. The application deadline and decision deadline occur early.

**COMMITMENT:** 

BINDING

Restrictive Early Action (REA)

#### **DEFINITION:**

Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED or EA or REA to other institutions. If offered enrollment, they have until May 1 to confirm.

COMMITMENT:

NON-BINDING

Students are responsible for determining and following restrictions.

## SAT/ACT WAIVERS

- Students who have been approved through GCPS for Free/Reduced Lunch qualify for SAT and ACT Fee Waivers.
- It is advised not to pick these up too early as they can easily be lost. Get your fee waiver when you are ready to register for the SAT or ACT.



#### WHERE TO APPLY

Mean

- Less than 30%
   chance of admission
- Your academic record and test scores are at or above average

Jagg

- 30-60% chance of admission
- Your academic record and test scores are in line with the average admissions statistics

Safety

- Greater than 60% chance of admission
- Your academic record and test scores are above average
- You need at least one safety school

### ACCESSING HOPE GPA

- Preliminary HOPE GPAs are available on GAfutures.
  - Students can create an account now.
  - Need to have SSN on file at Brookwood in order to access HOPE GPA.
  - SSN must also be entered into the student's account on GAfutures





### GEORGIA MATCH

- Students need to have their SSN on file at Brookwood and in their GAfutures to participate.
- Letter arrives in Sept-Oct.
- All students have to do is log into GAfutures and "claim" their spot.



## Major SCHOLARSHIPS

- Golden Doors Scholarship Deadline 10/01/2023
  - Covers full cost of attendance to any one of partners schools
  - Specifically for DACA, Undocumented, or TPS students
- Dream.US Scholarship (Opportunity or National Scholarship) - Deadline 02/26/2024
  - Covers full cost of attendance to any one of partners schools
  - Specifically for DACA, Undocumented, or TPS students
- Hispanic Scholarship Fund Deadline 02/15/2023
  - \$500-\$5,000 awarded to students of Hispanic descent

- Posse Foundation Scholarship Program
  - Full Tuition Scholarship to 1 of 6 partner colleges
- Quest Bridge Scholarship Deadline 9/26/2023
  - Covers full cost of attendance to any partner college
- Gates Scholarship Deadline 9/15/2023
  - covers cost that hasn't already been covered through FAFSA or other aid (last dollar funding)
- Coca Cola Scholarship Deadline 10/02/2023
  - \$20,000 awarded to 150 students
- Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Deadline 11/16/2023
  - covers cost that hasn't already been covered through FAFSA or other aid (last dollar funding)
- McDonalds HACER Scholarship 02/24/24
  - Up to \$100,000 awarded
  - Open to all students
