



## DULUTH HIGH SCHOOL Summer Program 2024



Dear student and family,

If you are receiving this letter, your student may be eligible to participate in the Duluth High School 2024 Summer Program *free of charge*. Our records indicate you/your student has failed OR is in danger of failing one of the courses needed for graduation. \*\*\*If this is incorrect, please disregard this letter.\*\*\*

Beginning on **June 11, 2024**, and ending on **July 3, 2024**, Duluth High School will offer a Summer Program with the courses listed below. **To be eligible, a student must have previously failed the course.** The classes will be an Online Hybrid model with students working in content rooms with a content teacher (for example, Science Room, Math Room, etc.). There is NO CHARGE for these classes. Upperclassmen are given priority.

**Registration closes May 23, 2024 at 2:00 pm and is subject to counselor approval.**

Important information:

- Classes are Monday – Friday, June 11 - July 3, 2024
- 1<sup>st</sup> session (AM) 7 :00 – 11:00 am, 2<sup>nd</sup> session (PM) 11:30 am – 3:30 pm
- Meals: Snacks available for purchase, please bring lunch.
- No school June 19, 2024
- Final exams: July 3, 2024; 1<sup>st</sup> session exam 7 – 9 am (break 9 – 9:15 am), 2<sup>nd</sup> session exam 9:15 – 11:15 am
- July 3, 2024: Graduation for all of GCPS Summer School, Gas South Arena, 4 pm
- *Attendance is mandatory for all classes:* Students missing more than one day will be removed. All excused and unexcused absences count.
  - o Tardies: 3 tardies = 1 absence
  - o Late to class (more than 30 minutes) = 1 absence
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> absence = withdrawal from program

There is no transportation provided. Students must provide their own transportation.

## 2024 Summer School Class Offerings
