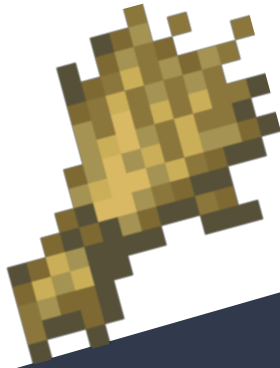


GMA Project:

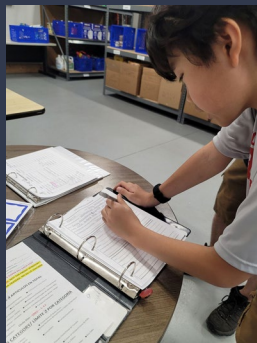
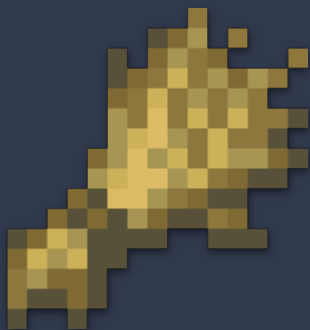

Why am I doing this?

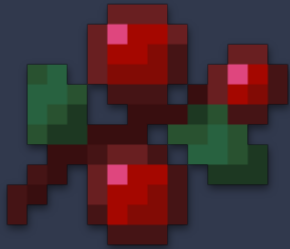


There should always be more trees to go around!



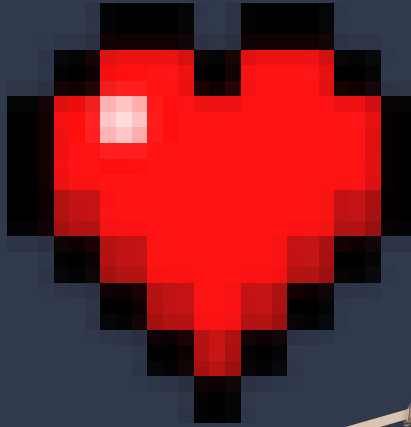
