

The Classical Literature Club Bylaws

I. OFFICIAL NAME

The official name of this organization shall be the Classical Literature Club.

II. PURPOSE

To read and discuss the classics of literature in a casual setting, by reading one classic work every month.

III. MEMBERSHIP

Qualification of Membership: The club has an open membership policy to any interested students at BHS. Interested students can sign up to read a book each month, and signing up one month does not mean the student is obligated to sign up the next month.

Financial Obligations of Members: The members have the responsibility to pay for the classic work without the intervention of the club. They may choose either to find a free version online, or buy the book on their own time. On a monthly basis, the club will release information on the options of how the particular book can be acquired by the students.

IV. OFFICERS

The Classical Literature Club has a President and Vice President for this student-led club:

President: The President will attend and head meetings. The President has the primary responsibility for all of the club's functions and coordinating all the meetings. The President must also conduct relations between the vice president and the club sponsor. The President will act as the official representative of the Classical Literature Club. The President, along with the Vice President and club sponsor, has the responsibility to pick the books read each month, and facilitate the activities within the meeting.

Vice President: This officer will be in charge of attending meetings, particularly those that the President is unable to attend. The Vice President will assist in planning events and oversee the activities of the meetings in the club as well as the President.

V. LEADERSHIP PROCEDURES

The President serves up until his or her graduation, and with the collaboration of the club sponsor and the current Vice President, chooses another president. The three authoritative positions (President, Vice President, and club sponsor) will then also choose a Vice President that will serve up until graduation as well. Students that would like to be President or Vice President have to fill out an application that will be read and

discussed between the current President and Vice President.

VI. MEETINGS

The Classical Literature Club will meet every other Tuesday starting September 15, 2020. The President and Vice President will meet with the club sponsor a week before each meeting to discuss the logistics of the meeting, as well as the content.

VII. AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

These by-laws may need to be amended to accommodate the changing needs of the club if the sponsor feels it is necessary. The President and Vice President will be responsible for relaying any amendments.
