Good Food and a Good Value

- For elementary students, a student breakfast costs \$1.50, and a student lunch is \$2.25.
- Students who qualify for reduced-price meals pay \$0.30 for breakfast and \$0.40 for lunch.
- Students also may qualify for free meals.

How do you apply for free and reduced-price meals?

- Apply online (beginning July 16, 2024) at gwinnett.schoolunchapp.com



Provide all required information so your child's application can be processed. Incomplete information will delay the process. You can also get a paper application from your child's school.

- Allow 10 days to process the application.
- Check your application status at: gwinnett.schoolunchstatus.com.
