
For 11th grade Creative Writing, students need to read <u>two</u> books.

1. Lu Chi's Wen Fu The Art of Writing



- 2. Students will then pick one genre and read a book from that specific genre:
 - a. Here is an example of a book from each genre. Note that students do not have to read the books listed below. This is simply an example.
 - i. Fiction: Where the Crawdads Sing by Delia Ownes
 - ii. Non-Fiction: Me Talk Pretty One Day by David Sedaris
 - iii. Poetry: *milk and honey* by Rupi Kaur
 - iv. Screenplay: *Casablanca* by Julius Epstein, Philip Epstein, and Howard Koch
 - v. Drama: *A Streetcar Named Desire* by Tennessee Williams

Assignment: Students will need to read and annotate both their choice genre book and Lu Chi's Wen Fu *The Art of Writing*.

Please note that annotations mean that you are engaging with the text. Appropriate annotations include side notes, definitions, questions, and other written notes in the margins. Annotations are NOT simply highlighting a lot.

Students will be evaluated on both the written annotations as well as the contributions to the Socratic seminar discussion.
