



## Peachtree Ridge High School's Ridge Recovery Program

2023-2024



Ridge Recovery is a credit recovery program for students who did not pass a class and earned a final grade between the ranges of 50% to 69% (listed below). Peachtree Ridge High School utilizes Georgia Virtual School Credit Recovery (GVCR) as the tool. Students can take a condensed version of the course to earn credit towards graduation. After the successful completion of the GVCR course, the credit recovery grade will appear on a student's transcript at the end of each semester, however, the recovered grade will NOT replace the previously failed grade.

**Who is eligible?** Students who have previously taken a course (for which CR is available) and earned a final grade of 50% to 69%. Please note that CR is offered at a standard, college preparatory class level. Resource, Co-Taught, Honors, Gifted, and Advanced Placement courses are not available. In addition, Accelerated Math courses are not available.

**When are Ridge Recovery Support Sessions?** Ridge Recovery support sessions and registration dates are listed below. All Sessions will be at Peachtree Ridge High School (room locations will be communicated before the session).

- Session 1- Tuesday, October 24, 2023- Friday, October 27, 2023 from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.  
Registration/Fee Payment : October 4, 2023 and closes at 11:59 PM on October 20, 2023.
- Session 2- Tuesday, January 16, 2024- Friday, January 19, 2024 from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.  
Registration/Fee Payment: December 13, 2023 and closes at 11:59 PM on January 12, 2024.
- Session 3- Tuesday, March 26, 2024- Friday, March 29, 2024 from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.  
Registration/Fee Payment: March 8, 2024 and closes at 11:59 PM on March 22, 2024.
- Session 4- Peachtree Ridge High School and Gwinnett County Public Schools will announce Summer School and Credit Recovery details later in Spring 2024 Semester.

### How does the program work?

- Peachtree Ridge uses an online self-paced class with embedded tests for Credit Recovery. Students will need their own personal device. Ridge Recovery has been successful for students, however successful completion is not guaranteed.
- Students may take only ONE full credit (or two .5 credits) during Ridge Recovery course per semester.
- **NCAA does NOT recognize this Credit Recovery program for eligibility purposes**
- **Students will have to take the EOC in EOC Courses to earn credit.\* (Courses are identified by an asterisk)**
- Special Education and 504 accommodations are NOT supported by the Credit Recovery program (self-elected)

### What is the cost for the Ridge Recovery?

- \$40 payable on mypaymentsplus.com (non-refundable). Students must pay regardless of attendance at Ridge Recovery Sessions.
- This fee will be used to pay teachers for Ridge Recovery sessions and student intervention programs at PRHS.

### How do I sign my student up for Ridge Recovery?

1. To sign up for Ridge Recovery, log into your mypaymentsplus.com account on a computer, (1) select *Events and Activities*, (2) then select *School Fees*, and (3) the Ridge Credit Recovery session your child wants to sign up for. **Please ensure you input a valid email address (not school email).**
2. Please visit Georgia Virtual Credit Recovery website to create an account if your student does not have one ([www.gacreditrecovery.org](http://www.gacreditrecovery.org)).
3. Registration and Fee Payment will close at 11:59 PM on registration close date. Courses will reflect on student schedule after registration window closes.
