

2024 Parkview Advanced Placement Exam Information

Before the Day of Your AP Test

- Log on to your My AP Classroom account (myap.collegeboard.org) to review your registered exams.
- College Board is no longer accepting additional exam orders, and standby testing is not available this year.
- Review the schedule on the next page to know where and when to report for your exams.
- Go to apscore.org for information on receiving your AP scores and sending your scores to colleges.

On the Day of Your AP Test - Arrive on time or you will not be able to take your exam!!

- If you are taking an AM exam, registration begins at 7:00 AM and **ENDS at 7:30 AM**. If you fail to show up to your exam by 7:30 AM, you will NOT be allowed to take your exam. Look on next page of this document to know where to report for your exam.
- If you are taking a PM exam, registration begins at 11:30 AM and **ENDS at 12:00 PM**. If you fail to show up to your exam by 12:00 PM, you will not be allowed to take your exam. Look on the next page of this document to know where to report.
- If you have both an AM exam and a PM exam on the same day, you will report to your PM test once your AM test is finished. Bring a sack lunch with you as you will have a limited amount of time to eat a snack between exams.
- ***DO NOT BE LATE. Set multiple alarms. Once we have started testing, you may not enter the testing room. There are no refunds for missed exams.***
- You are not required to attend your Parkview classes before/after the testing period on a day you are scheduled to take an AP exam. You will be marked ACT (school activity/present) for the day. If you have an EOC, final, or other exam scheduled that same day, **your AP exam takes priority**.
- See the information below about the items you may and may not bring into the exam room. Please read carefully.

What You Should Bring to the Exam Room <i>(Make sure you have all of the required items when you come for your test.)</i>	What You <u>MUST NOT</u> Bring to the Exam Room
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Valid photo ID (government-issued or school-issued). ○ Parkview student ID number. ○ School code if you are testing at a different school than your own (Parkview's code: 111826). ○ Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers AND pens with black or dark blue ink. We will NOT provide these. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities IF you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus AB/BC, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics I, Physics C, or Statistics Exam. We do NOT provide calculators or batteries. Visit https://apstudent.collegeboard.org/takingtheexam/exam-policies/calculator-policy and http://apstudent.collegeboard.org/apcourse and click the link for your course for the specific calculator policy. ○ A ruler or straightedge only if you are taking a Physics exam (no protractors). ○ A snack for before testing, during break, and/or after testing (absolutely no eating or drinking during testing). ○ A sack lunch / snack if you have two tests the same day because you will not have time to go out for lunch between exams. ○ Make sure your clothing is appropriate. You may want to dress in layers in case you get hot or cold. Make sure your clothing is school appropriate! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES WHATSOEVER!</u> No cell phones, smart phones, smart watches, laptops, tablets, iPods, cameras, etc. <i>DO NOT BRING ELECTRONIC DEVICES INTO THE TESTING ROOM!!</i> ○ Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils ○ Scratch paper ○ Watches that beep or have an alarm, or smart watches. ○ Clothing with subject-related information

After the Day of Your AP Test

- Check apscore.org after exams for the exact date your scores will be available online. Also look for a reminder in July about online score availability at the email address associated with your College Board account.

Missing your AP Exam

- **If you miss your registered AP exam, you will be charged an additional \$40 returned exam fee. This fee is PER MISSED EXAM.**
- College Board is not allowing exam cancellations / refunds this year. Students must take all registered exam or pay the \$40 returned exam fee for each missed exam.
- If you are not able to take your exam on the scheduled day for a *legitimate* reason (severe illness, medical emergency, or family tragedy), you must notify Mr. Nichols at doug.nichols@gcpsk12.org to request late testing no later than the day of your missed in-person exam.

Transportation
