



## Seckinger High School Summer School & Credit Recovery Options – May 2024

The following programs allow students an opportunity to earn credit for a required graduation course that they did not pass in the classroom.



Seniors Only Credit Recovery	Extended Learning/ExL	SKG Summer School
<p>12<sup>th</sup> graders who do not pass a required course for graduation may register for Credit Recovery or School Plus. CR courses are taken online through Georgia Virtual School. School Plus courses are taken with a certified teacher. Lessons are self-paced, and tests and the final exam are embedded.</p>	<p>9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders who do not pass a required <b>MATH or SCIENCE</b> class (final grade between 62-69%) will complete remediation with a content area teacher at the end of the semester. Once remediation is complete, students will have the opportunity to retake the final exam, or another unit test, to earn a passing score and credit for the course.</p>	<p>9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders who do not pass a required CORE class can retake the course through Summer Credit Recovery held at SKG. CR courses are taken online through Georgia Virtual School. Lessons are self-paced, and tests and the final exam are embedded.</p>

<p>All required courses must be completed no later than May 21<sup>st</sup> in order to participate in the graduation ceremony on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.</p>	<p>ExL provides an opportunity to pass a course before the semester ends.</p>	<p>CR courses are <u>not</u> NCAA approved. Students may complete more than one CR course during this session.</p>

<p><b>Attendance is required EVERY day of the program session until the course is finished.</b></p>		

- All courses are offered at a standard, College Preparatory class level. AP & Honors are not offered; Special Education & 504 accommodations are not supported through these programs.
- Credit Recovery grades appear on the student’s transcript, but they will not replace the failed grade. Extended Learning grades will appear as the final grade in the semester that course is taken. School Plus is NCAA approved.
- Students should bring their own food to consume on a break during the sessions.

\*\*Students are required to take the Georgia End of Course (EOC) exam for these courses to finalize their grade.

### How to Register for Credit Recovery or ExL:

1. Log in to your **MyPaymentsPlus.com** account and click on **“Events and School Fees.”**
2. Follow the prompts to pay for Seckinger HS “SKG Seniors Only Credit Recovery” or “SKG Summer School” or “SKG Extended Learning.”
3. If your student is taking a CR course for the second time, there is an additional \$25 GAVS CR Retake Fee that must be paid on MPP.
4. Your student’s counselor will review the transcript and register your student for the correct CR course. **You do not need to select the student’s required course at the time of registration.**
5. Students must meet attendance and behavior expectations. Students who do not meet such expectations will be withdrawn from CR /ExL. **Payment will not be refunded, and students will not be rolled over to a future CR session.** Students will need to re-register and re-pay to take the missed course in a future session.
6. All CR STUDENTS must complete steps to either activate or establish their accounts on GA Virtual School. Please choose the option below that is appropriate for your student and click on the corresponding link.
  - o If your student already has a Georgia Virtual Credit Recovery account:
