



IMMUNIZATION REMINDER

Georgia law requires children attending a school or childcare facility be protected from certain vaccine-preventable diseases.

For the 2023-2024 school year: all students entering or transferring into 11th grade will need proof that they received a meningococcal booster vaccine (MCV4) on or after their 16th birthday.

- MCV4 vaccines must be documented on Georgia Form 3231 Certificate of Immunization.
- Students who are not 16 years old do not have to get the vaccine until their 16th birthday.
- Note that this booster vaccine is required in addition to the MCV4 vaccine that was required for your child prior to his or her beginning 7th grade.


Please make sure your student's immunizations are up to date. We MUST have a current GEORGIA Certificate of Immunization (Form #3231) on file for each student enrolled at Mill Creek OR a notarized statement of religious exemption (Form #2208). A medical exemption, if applicable, should be noted on Form #3231 with a current date of expiration. We will be conducting an audit of our students and failure to comply can result in Spring schedules being held or withdrawn.




EPIC UPDATES
