**We have seen a 10% drop in school-wide behavior incidences from the 2022-2023 school year to 2023-2024 school year.**

**We attribute this to a greater focus on teaching and modeling expectations, as well as recognizing and rewarding positive behaviors on a frequent basis.**

**We are also focused on recognizing when students need extra support, as well as helping all students to develop great decision-making skills.**

# GRAYSON ELEMENTARY PBIS/SEL IMPLEMENTATION

Initiatives	2022-2023	2023-2024
SEL Lessons	Year 1 – Introduced with a daily slide	Year 2 – Fully implemented with daily Character Strong Curriculum lessons and corresponding messages streamed throughout the school. Administration discusses the monthly topic on announcements twice a week.
PBIS Market	Year 1- Students shopped a small version of a market with Rams points they earned.	Year 2 – Full implementation with wider selection of items. More teachers are recognizing and rewarding students. Students are excited to save up for larger and higher priced items.
Staff Development	Brief overview of PBIS implementation at preplanning	Daily preplanning small group sessions. 8-week session on implementing a Calming Corner with a cross-section of teachers.
Parent Workshops	Mindfulness Drop-in Room, in conjunction with another school event, to acquaint parents with SEL.	PBIS/SEL Night with 5 sessions, enlightening parents on a variety of topics to help build character and implement SEL at home.
