

# 2024-2025 Lanier High School Credit Recovery

## General Info:

- Credit Recovery is available to students who failed a class required for a diploma.
- Each Course is **\$50** and students **MUST** complete the course within the 4 week timespan of the minimester.
- Student attendance is **Mandatory** Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday (2:30-4:00pm) in Lab 702. Students can also complete coursework at home to help them progress through the course(s) quicker.
- Students who do not complete their credit recovery course by the end of the Minimester will need to register for the next Minimester session and **pay an additional \$50** in order to continue working on the course.
- **Note: Credit Recovery courses are NOT honored by the NCAA Eligibility Center.**

## How to Register:

- Cost is \$50/class. Minimester sessions listed below:  
Registration for each Minimester ends on the night of the first day of the session.  
If you miss the registration window, you will have to sign up for the next Minimester.

- 1) After logging into MyPaymentsPlus, go to: Events and Activities > Community School > Lanier Community School > LHS Credit Recovery

- 6) Ms. Guttinger will register you for the course you need prior to the first day of the minimester.

## Credit Recovery Course Structure:

- **Pre-tests:** Pass with an 85% or higher to skip learning activities.
- **Learning Activities:** Complete readings, videos, quizzes, etc. Language arts classes have a required essay that must be submitted before completion of Post-tests and access to Final Exam. **Essays can only be attempted once.**
- **Post-tests (80% of your final grade):** Pass with a 70% or higher to proceed to the next unit. You will be able to retake the Post-tests as many times as needed to pass.
- **Final EXAM (20% of final grade)- MUST Complete with a TEACHER** after scoring passing grades on ALL Post-tests. **Note: Final EXAM can only be taken ONE TIME.** There are NO Resets on Finals.

**You will Complete the Final with a TEACHER, [email Ms. Guttinger](mailto:Ms.Guttinger) to set up a day/time to take your final exam.** You will have options of: During School Day (Longhorn Time; After School Tuesday-Thursday 2:30-4:00pm, and Some online options in the evening or on possible Saturdays depending on availability. You will be assigned a specific day/time by Ms. Guttinger after completing the Google Final Exam Request Form.
