

SENIOR LETTERS ARE DUE APRIL 10, 2024

What are they?

Senior letters are positive sentiments for graduating seniors congratulating them on their accomplishments and wishing them luck in their next chapter.

Where can I submit one?

Letters can be turned into the box located in the front office or mailed to the school. <u>Emailed</u> <u>letters will not be accepted</u>. Be sure to write the student's **legal** first and last name.

When are they due?

Senior letters must be turned in by **April 10th** and will be distributed to students during their senior breakfast on April 18, 2024.

What can I include?

Letters written on paper or stationary cards are the most common types, and will be the <u>only</u> letters accepted. All stationary cards and letters MUST fit into a standard 10x13 envelope.

Please do not send items such as money, gift cards, gifts, or scrapbooks. If these are gifts you wish you send to a student, please send them directly to their home address. These items will be refused.



GRADUATION ATTIRE STYLE GUIDE

HOW TO WEAR REGALIA

- All seniors should wear the Lanier medallion (white ribbon, crest on the medal). You will receive it when you check in at graduation.
- If you have an NHS or other stole, wear it first, then cords, then medals.
- Do <u>NOT</u> decorate your caps. Flags and stoles not sanctioned by the school or GCPS are not allowed.
- No student may wear denim, t-shirts, flip-flops, or tennis shoes. Any student not appropriately dressed will not participate in the ceremony.

LADIES ATTIRE

- DARK (black, navy, dark brown) shoes.
 We will also allow nude (not pink) shoes.
 If you choose to wear high heels, be sure to practice walking in them!
- Dresses or top/skirt combo without excessively full skirts or high ruffled necklines; if you prefer, you may wear DARK pants.



GENTLEMEN ATTIRE



- DARK (black, navy, darn brown) slacks, DARK shoes, DARK socks.
- Dress shirt with a collar and a tie.

IMPORTANT UPDATES

Senior Dues

Senior dues cover cap and gown, senior events, senior t-shirt, and costs associated with the graduation ceremony. The deadline for dues payment at https://www.scholasticimages.com/ for timely delivery of the cap and gown to Lanier High School is Saturday, April 13th.

Announcements, Senior T-Shirt, and Cap and Gown Distribution

Scholastic Images will be on campus Friday, April 19th during all lunches to distribute caps and gowns and senior t-shirts. Students who have not paid their senior dues at that time will not receive a cap and gown or a senior t-shirt. Caps and gowns that are purchased after April 13th will be mailed home at the cost of the student. If you are unable to pick up your cap and gown on the scheduled day, there will be a Google form sent closer to the date to arrange alternate days for pickup.

Graduation Practice and Ceremony

Practice for graduation will be held on **Thursday, May 23rd, time TBD** in the Lanier HS Commons area. **Practice is mandatory** for any senior that is participating in the ceremony. **Any fines, fees, etc. must be paid prior to the graduation practice to receive graduation tickets, which are distributed during practice.** Graduation practice is closed to all parents and other spectators.

The commencement ceremony will be held on Friday, May 24th at 7:30 PM at the Gas South Arena. Graduates should arrive no later than 5:30 PM. Guests can enter beginning at 6:30 PM.

Graduation Ceremony Tickets

Each graduate is allotted **at least ten (10) tickets.** Tickets are distributed at the <u>end of graduation practice</u>. If we are able to accommodate requests for additional tickets, students will be notified in May.

GRADUATION ETIQUETTE

This is truly a time for excitement and celebrations as the graduates have worked hard to reach this point in their lives. However, a graduation ceremony is a formal ceremony, and at Lanier High School, we have put together the following guidelines (per county and Arena guidelines) for attire and behavior to ensure <u>respect</u>, <u>uniformity</u>, and <u>decorum</u> during the ceremony:

GRADUATION ATTIRE- for the graduates

Ladies:

- Dresses or top/skirt combo without excessively full skirts or high ruffled necklines; if you prefer, you may also wear DARK pants.
- DARK (black, navy, dark brown) shoes. If you choose to wear high heels, be sure to practice walking in them! That floor is slippery!

Gentlemen:

- DARK (black, navy, dark brown) slacks, DARK shoes, DARK socks
- Dress shirt and tie

Ladies and Gentlemen:

• Your cap and gown ©

NO STUDENT should wear denim, t-shirts, flip-flops or tennis shoes. **Students not appropriately dressed will not march.**

GRADUATION ETIQUETTE- for the graduates

- ARRIVE ON TIME. We cannot stress this enough!! If changes are necessary for the ceremony, you want to make sure you know what is going on!
- Dress appropriately for the ceremony using the guidelines above.
- Leave all extras (purses, keys, cell phones, etc.) with parents or relatives. If you bring them, we will collect and hold them until Tuesday, May 28th. Items may be picked up at the school.
- Do **NOT** decorate your cap or gown in any way. Only Lanier HS approved cords/stoles will be worn.

GRADUATION ETIQUETTE- for parents, relatives and friends

- Adhere to the clear bag and security policies of the Arena.
- Arrive prior to the start of the ceremony. You will not be allowed in until after the processional and Pledge of Allegiance if you arrive after the scheduled start time.
- Applaud only when appropriate. Excessive applause or noisemakers will not be tolerated. These are Arena guidelines.
- Please only take pictures or video from your seat.
- Remember- a ticket will be needed to enter the arena. Small children will also need a ticket to enter.
- Cell phones should be powered off or set to silent.



CLEAR BAG POLICY

In the interest of enhancing existing security measures and enforcing the most touch-free experience possible, Gas South District is introducing a Clear Bag Policy. The safest and fastest way to enter Gas South District is to not bring a bag at all.
