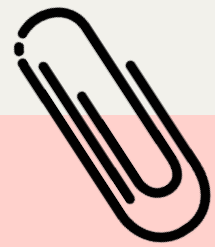

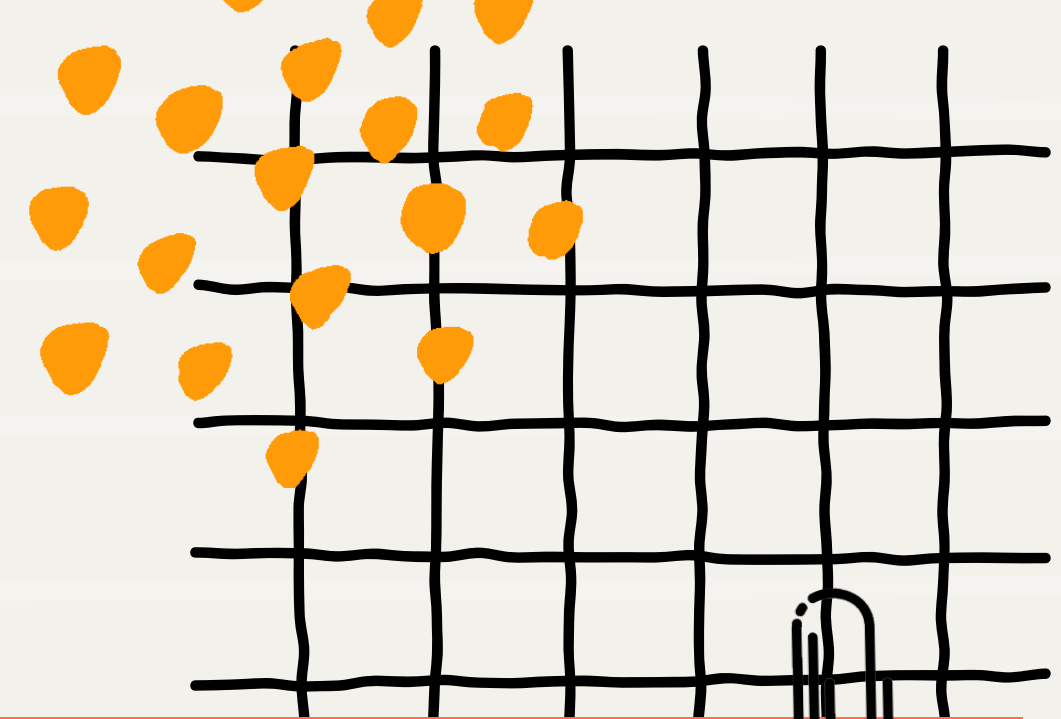

We offer AP Courses in every core subject area, plus World Languages, Music, Art, Research, and Computer Science



College Level Courses

College Credit



AP offers students the opportunity to take college-level courses and exams in high school, with the potential to earn college credit and/or advanced placement in courses at many colleges. The AP Exams are standardized exams designed to measure how well students have mastered the content and skills of the course.

study OBJECTIVES



College Prep

General academic coursework that prepares students for college and/or post-secondary plans

Honors & Gifted

Requires doing homework on a consistent basis, active participation in class, and reading and studying outside of class. Honors/Gifted classes have the same course standards. They are both higher level classes than CP.

Advanced Placement

AP course-work is demanding and recommended for students who are mature with strong study skills. AP classes are writing intensive and rigorous. It is recommended that students take the exam for the course. It is our hope every student consider taking at least one AP course during high school

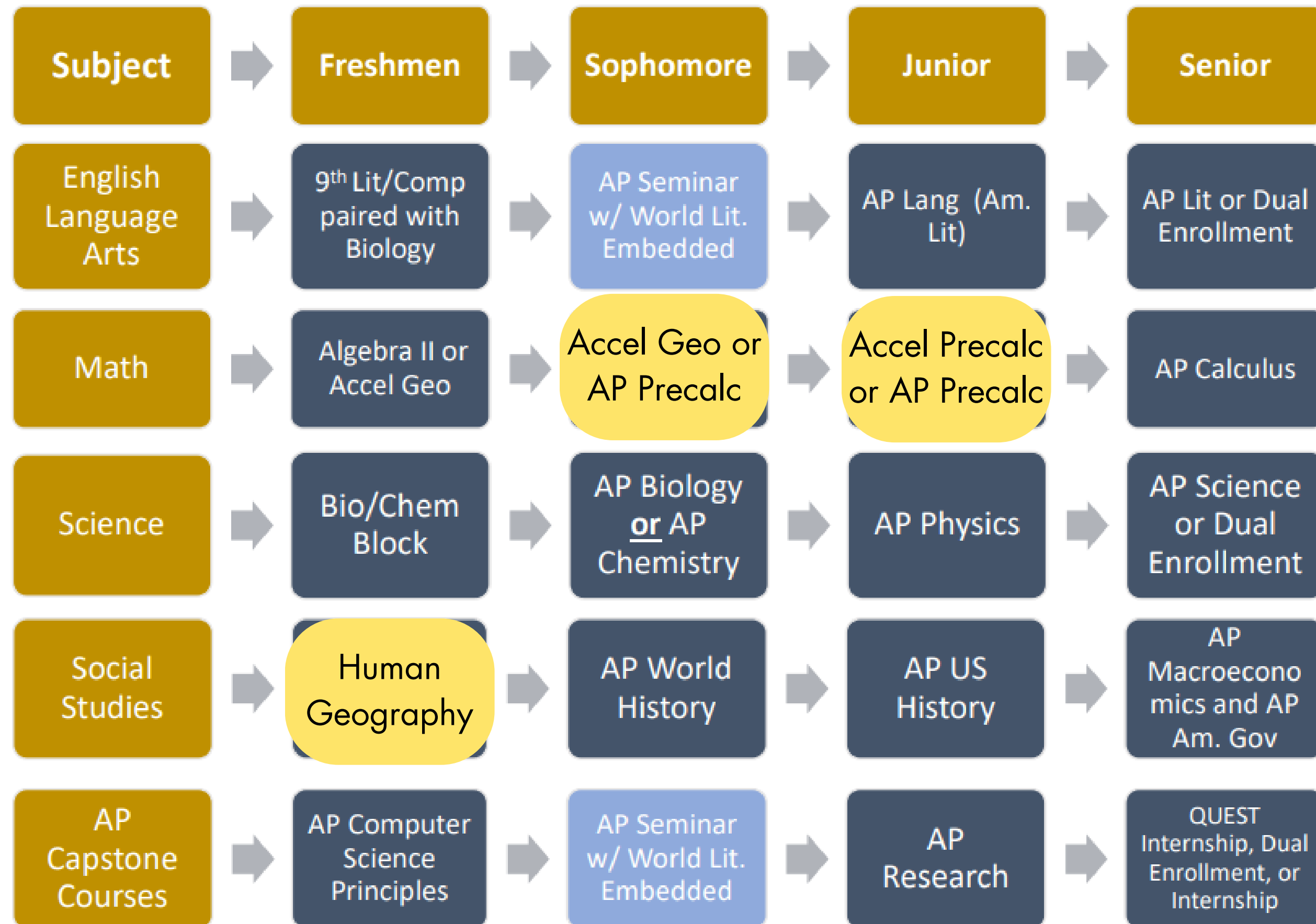

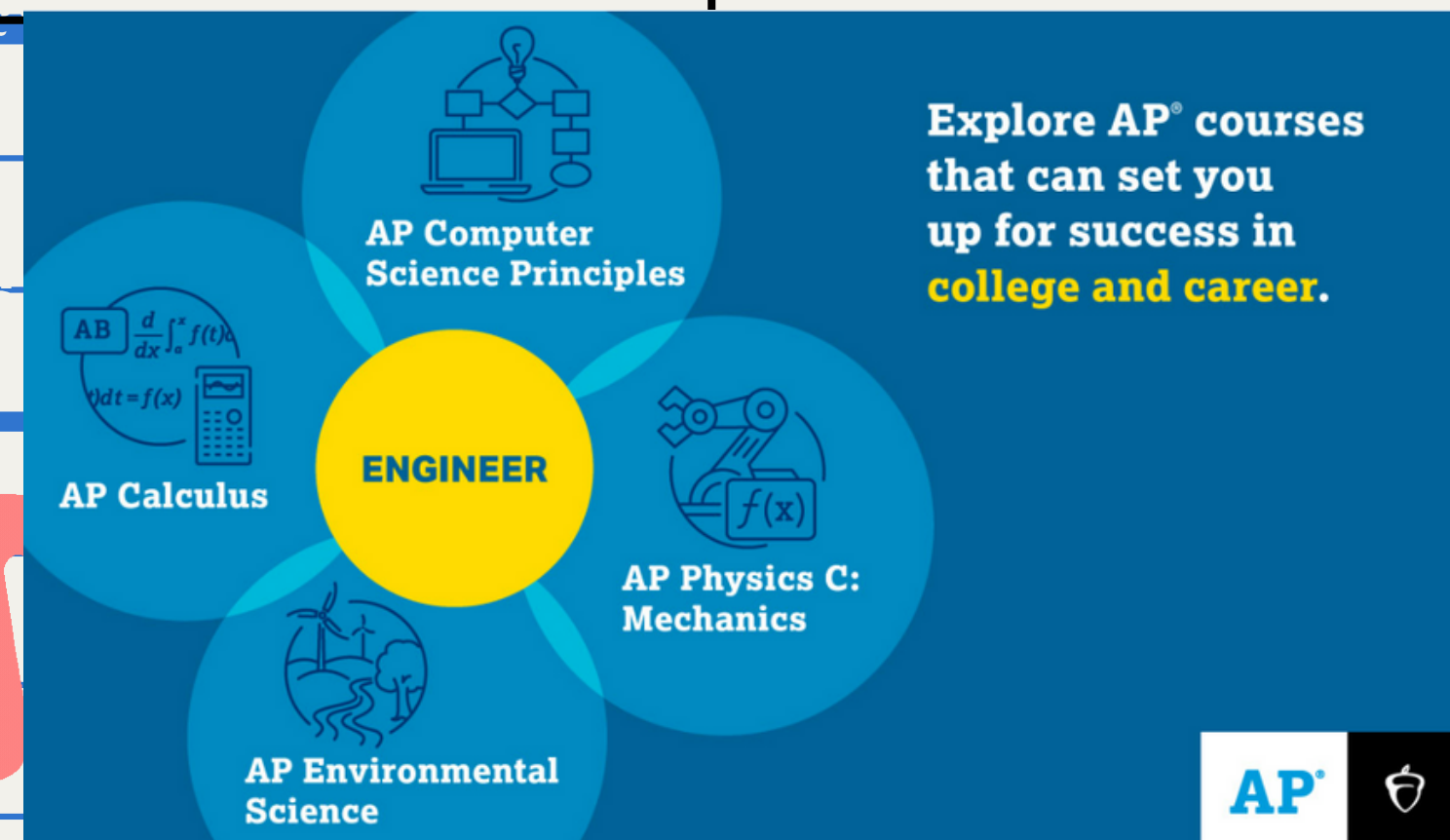

AP EXAM FEES



All Students will pay the **\$10 non-refundable registration fee**, along with any other exam costs, at [MyPaymentsPlus.com](https://mypaymentsplus.com)

GCPS will pay for 1 exam(\$98) for each student, as long as they are enrolled in the course for which they are testing.

GCPS will only pay \$98 for an AP Capstone Exam (AP Seminar OR AP Research); the parent/student is responsible for the additional **\$48** and will be billed \$48 in My Payments Plus.

Each additional exam is **\$98.00**, with the exception of AP Capstone Exams (AP Seminar or AP Research), which are **\$146.00** each.

GCPS Students who are Free/Reduced Lunch students and enrolled in AP Courses:
Gwinnett County Public Schools will pay for all exams after the \$10 registration fee.

The fee of \$40.00 for any exam that is a late order, requires late-testing, or is cancelled (and does not meet College Board approved guidelines) has been reinstated.



Recognition and Awards

- **AP Capstone Diploma or the AP Seminar and Research Certificate - Gold Collar at Graduation**
 - Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research and on four additional AP Exams of their choosing receive the AP Capstone Diploma.
 - Students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research but not on four additional AP Exams receive the AP Seminar and Research Certificate.
- **AP Scholar Achievement Award**—AP Scholar is a student who has earned a 3 or higher on three or more AP exams
- **AP Scholar with Honor**—AP Scholar with Honor is a student who has received an average score of 3.25 on all AP exams taken and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams
- **AP Scholar with Distinction**—AP Scholar with Distinction has earned an average score of 3.5 on all AP exams taken and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
